God's Work Through Our Hands

As of June 28, 2019, 282 pledges and one time donations to our *God's Work Through Our Hands* capital campaign have resulted in \$880,000 pledged and \$519,114.64 received and interest earned. We are very excited to reach these project milestones:

- After interviewing six architects twice, William A. Kibbe & Associates from Saginaw was selected to complete our renovation project based on these priorities: #1 – interior renovations, #2 – narthex and #3 – exterior/facade.
- St. Jude Liturgical Arts Studio was also interviewed twice and has been selected to redesign the church interior to give it a stronger, more transcendent Catholic identity within our budget. St. Jude will serve as our liturgical consultant, designer and supplier.

These two firms collaborated to complete the recent cathedral renovation and are involved in other “parish-sized” projects within the diocese including St. Michael's in Maple Grove (Father John Cotter's parish).
