With the initial success of our *God's Work Through Our Hands* campaign, we wanted to share this recent email from Mr. Tim Muter, Director of Facilities and Construction Services for the Diocese of Saginaw detailing the next steps for our parish renovation project:

“You have authorization to make your final prints of interior and exterior. The plans must then be submitted to me for building commission recommendation and Liturgy office recommendations to Bishop. If ok'd then you will be allowed to go to final bid. It is possible you may be required to appear before building commission to explain your project. I will see after I receive final plans and specifications.”
